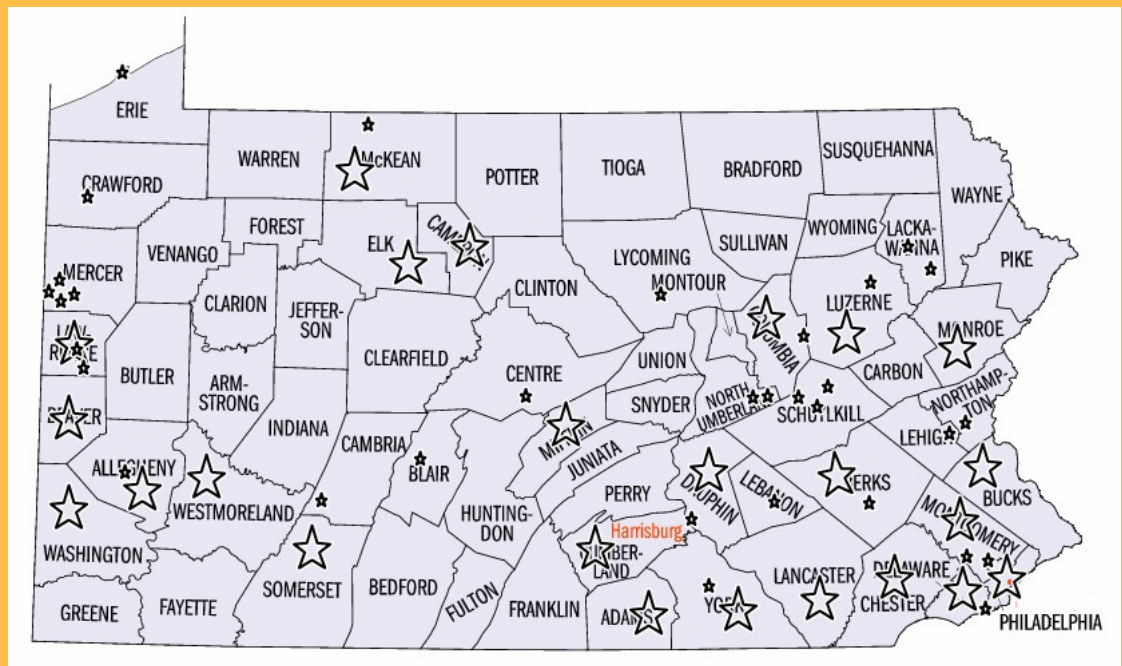

EXAMPLES OF FUNDED PROJECTS IN PA:

Brunswick Farms Apartments, in Lancaster County, will provide a total of 60 units of rental housing for families. The Redevelopment Authority, through the County's allocation of HUD funding, has financed the project with HOME funds in the amount of \$1 million.



At Park View at Manchester Heights, York County, residents are provided with social and recreational activities, education and health seminars, 24-hour emergency maintenance, and business services. The building has 64 affordable units for older adults.
