


# BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA



## THE PROBLEM: AGING HOUSING STOCK

**One in four homes** in Beaver County were built over 85 years ago.



- **\$1,879,226 awarded to Beaver County through the Whole-Home Repairs Program.**

- **34 projects scheduled to be completed using Whole-Home Repairs funds so far.**


- **\$234,191 spent on home repairs completed using Whole-Home Repairs funds so far.**

## THE SOLUTION: HOME REPAIR PROGRAMS

Whole-Home Repairs Program funding is helping Beaver County address longstanding housing challenges by supporting critical home repairs, expanding workforce training, and beginning to reduce a growing waitlist of residents in need.

Training programs offered through local institutions are helping to prepare workers to meet the region's increasing demand for home upgrades and essential repairs.

**Beaver Falls, Patterson Heights, Big Beaver, West Mayfield, Racine and Eastvale** have the largest share of the oldest homes in the county.
