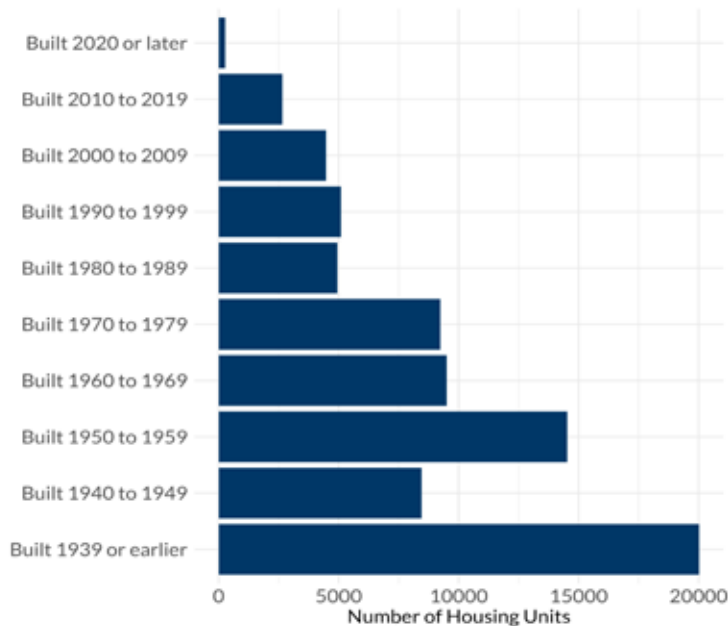


BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA



THE PROBLEM: AGING HOUSING STOCK

One in four homes in Beaver County were built **over 85 years ago**.



- **\$1,879,226** awarded to Beaver County through the Whole-Home Repairs Program.

- **34** projects scheduled to be completed using Whole-Home Repairs funds so far.

- **\$234,191** spent on home repairs completed using Whole-Home Repairs funds so far.

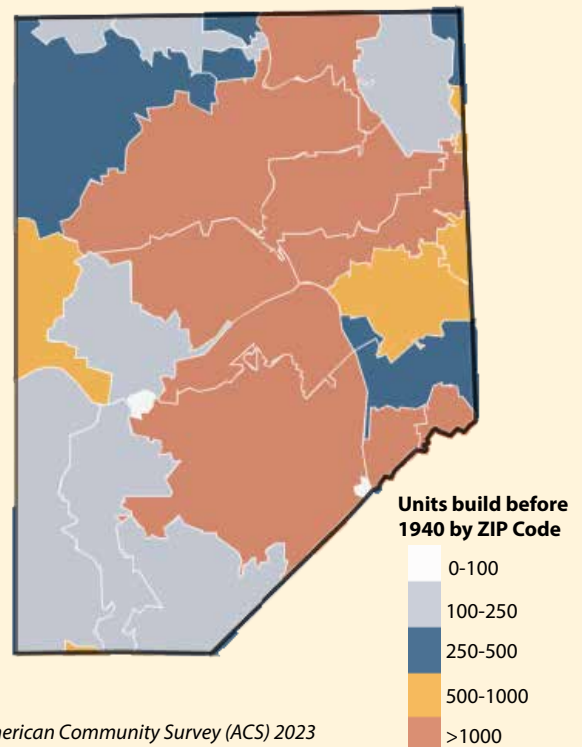
All information is current as of December 2024. The data reflects a snapshot of the program's impact and does not capture its full scope, as funding is still being distributed and used.

THE SOLUTION: HOME REPAIR PROGRAMS

Whole-Home Repairs Program funding is helping Beaver County address longstanding housing challenges by supporting critical home repairs, expanding workforce training, and beginning to reduce a growing waitlist of residents in need.

Training programs offered through local institutions are helping to prepare workers to meet the region's increasing demand for home upgrades and essential repairs.

Beaver Falls, Patterson Heights, Big Beaver, West Mayfield, Racine and Eastvale have the largest share of the oldest homes in the county.
