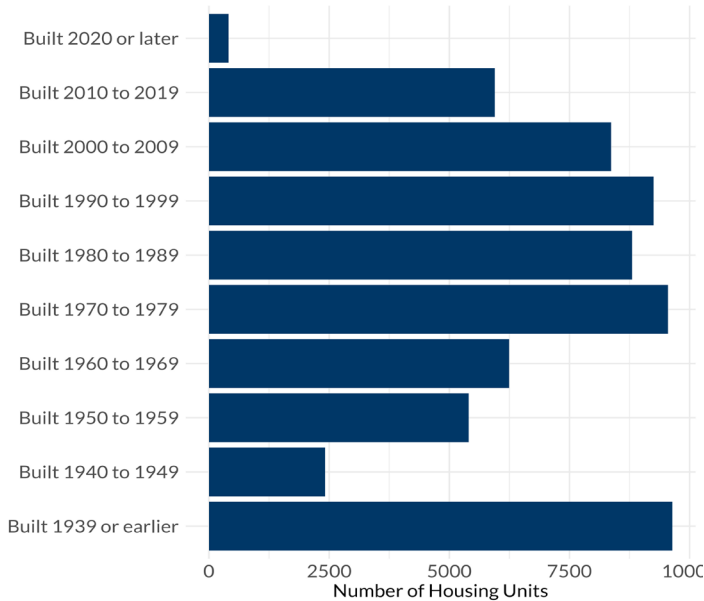

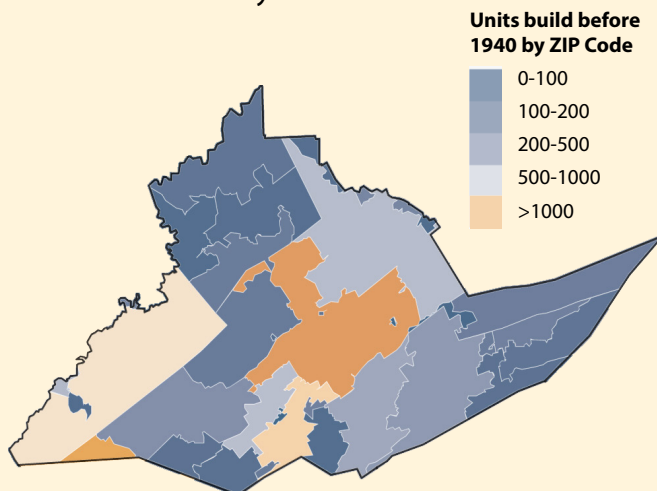


THE PROBLEM: AGING HOUSING STOCK

Over **one in ten homes** in Centre County were built **over 85 years ago**.



Bellefonte, Hublersburg, Pleasant Gap and Wingate have the largest share of the oldest homes in the county.

THE SOLUTION: HOME REPAIR PROGRAMS

The Whole-Home Repairs Program is helping Centre County address critical housing needs by supporting a range of essential home repairs, including roofing, windows, doors, siding, HVAC, bathroom and ADA upgrades, door widening, deck repairs and replacements, ramps, water damage remediation, and electrical work.

Through partnerships with Habitat for Humanity and the Builders Association of Central PA, the county is working to improve housing stability and accessibility for residents while also strengthening the local repair and construction workforce.

- **\$1,370,861** awarded to Centre County through the Whole-Home Repairs Program.

- **\$959,753** spent on home repairs through the Whole-Home Repairs Program so far.

- **58 households** have repairs completed so far.

- **128 projects** completed so far, including electrical, structural and ADA upgrades.

- **\$19,916** expended so far towards workforce development and training .
