




THE PROBLEM: AGING HOUSING STOCK

More than **one in four homes** in Clinton County were built **over 85 years ago**.



Lock Haven, McElhattan and Flemington have the largest share of the oldest homes in the county.



THE SOLUTION: HOME REPAIR PROGRAMS

Whole-Home Repairs Program funding is helping Clinton County address longstanding housing challenges by supporting critical home repairs, expanding workforce training, and beginning to reduce a growing waitlist of residents in need.

Training programs offered through local institutions are helping to prepare workers to meet the region's increasing demand for home upgrades and essential repairs.

- **\$281,146** awarded through the Whole-Home Repairs Program

- **\$151,705** spent on home repairs, including electrical, structural, plumbing, and HVAC work so far.

- **\$30,620** spent on workforce development and training so far.

- **17** trainees enrolled in two workforce development cohorts launched through the PCT's Clean Energy Center.

- **\$26,278** was the average income of households served through the program.

All information is current as of May 2025. The data reflects a snapshot of the program's impact and does not capture its full scope, as funding is still being distributed and used.

Whole-Home Repairs funds were used for:

- **Electrical repairs** throughout the home
- Replacing **HVAC system, water heater, and water treatment systems**
- Replacing **retaining wall, exterior door and installing smoke alarms**

Whole-Home Repairs funds were used to:

- Replace **electrical service and repair electrical hazards** throughout home
- Repair **sidewalk**
- Replace **windows and spouting**
- Repair **doors and replace basement stairs and railing**

- Replace **window**
- Replace **side porch and stairs**

- Repair **porch and paint exterior surfaces**
- Repair **electrical hazards, HVAC system, and install smoke alarms**
