


# LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA



## THE PROBLEM: AGING HOUSING STOCK

About **one in three homes** in Luzerne County were built **over 85 years ago**.



- **\$3,263,953** awarded to Luzerne County through the Whole-Home Repairs Program.

- **19** projects scheduled to be completed using Whole-Home Repairs funding so far.

- **\$416,591** spent on home repairs completed using Whole-Home Repair funding so far.


All information is current as of April 2024. The data reflects a snapshot of the program's impact and does not capture its full scope, as funding is still being distributed and used.

## THE SOLUTION: HOME REPAIR PROGRAMS

Whole-Home Repairs Program funding is helping Luzerne County address longstanding housing challenges by supporting critical home repairs, expanding workforce training, and beginning to reduce a growing waitlist of residents in need.

Training programs offered through local institutions are helping to prepare workers to meet the region's increasing demand for home upgrades and essential repairs.

**Wilkes-Barre, Laflin, Bear Creek Village, Georgetown and Westminister** have the largest share of the oldest homes in the county.
