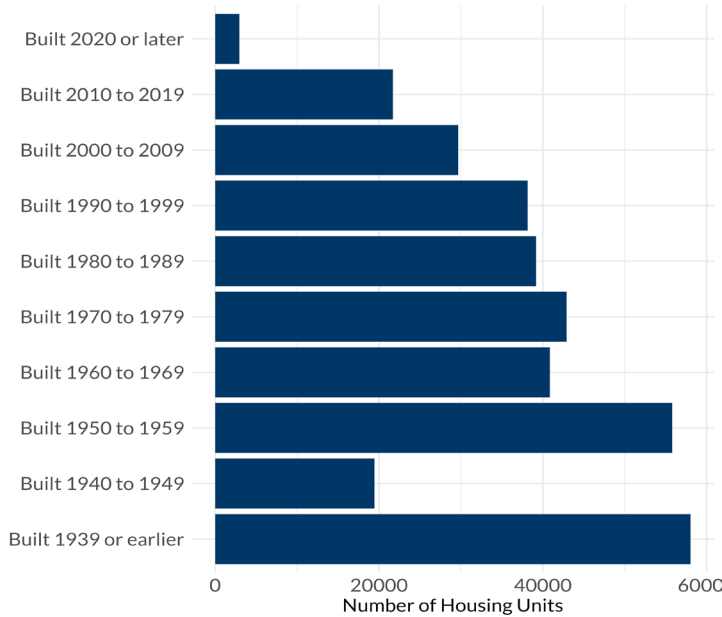
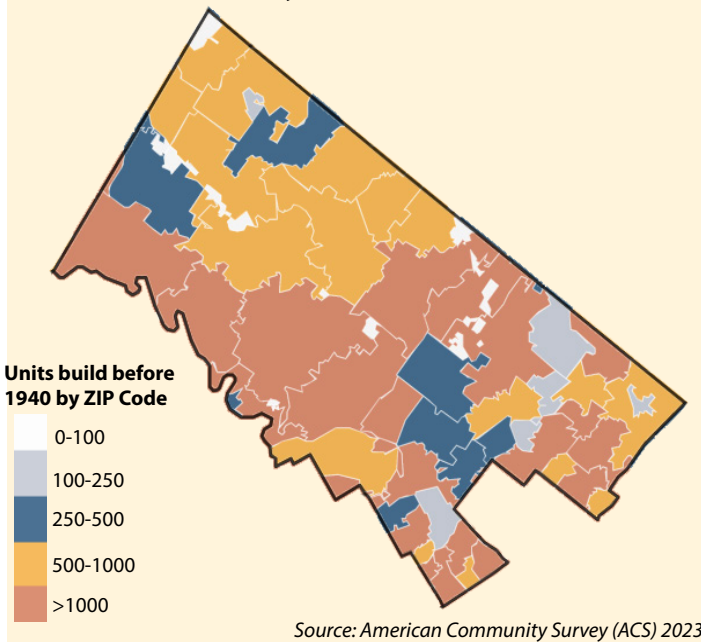


THE PROBLEM: AGING HOUSING STOCK

More than **one in ten homes** in Montgomery County were built **over 85 years ago**.



Norristown has the largest share of the oldest homes in the county.



All information is current as of April 2025. The data reflects a snapshot of the program's impact and does not capture its full scope, as funding is still being distributed and used.

THE SOLUTION: HOME REPAIR PROGRAMS

The Whole-Home Repairs Program is helping Montgomery County residents stay safely and comfortably in their homes by funding a wide range of essential repairs and accessibility upgrades.

Projects have included roof and gutter repair or replacement, HVAC system and water heater replacements, foundation repairs, and electrical and plumbing work.

The program has also supported the remediation of lead paint, asbestos, and mold; as well as kitchen accessibility, septic system repairs, driveway widening, and sidewalk installation or repair.

- **\$6,493,443** awarded to Montgomery County through the Whole-Home Repairs Program.

- **25** units have repairs completed using Whole-Home Repair funds so far.

- **\$40,000** expended towards workforce development and training so far.

- **101** projects scheduled to be completed using Whole-Home Repairs funds so far.
