




THE PROBLEM: AGING HOUSING STOCK

Close to **one in four homes** in Northampton County were built **over 85 years ago**.

THE SOLUTION: HOME REPAIR PROGRAMS

Whole-Home Repairs Program funding is helping Northampton County address longstanding housing challenges by supporting critical home repairs, expanding workforce training, and beginning to reduce a growing waitlist of residents in need.

Training programs offered through local institutions like Northampton Community College are helping to prepare workers to meet the region's increasing demand for home upgrades and essential repairs.

- **\$2,295,907** awarded to Northampton County through the Whole-Home Repair Program.

- **74** projects have repairs completed using Whole-Home Repairs funds so far.

- **\$78,942** expended so far towards workforce development and training.

All information is current as of April 2025. The data reflects a snapshot of the program's impact and does not capture its full scope, as funding is still being distributed and used.
