Housing Alliance Responds to Eviction Moratoriums Extension

Executive order protects renters and homeowners into July

Harrisburg (May 7, 2020) – Today Governor Wolf issued an executive order extending the eviction and foreclosure moratoriums. The extension protects renters and homeowners from eviction proceedings until July 10. The [Housing Alliance of Pennsylvania](#), which promotes common sense solutions to balance the state’s housing market and advocates for affordable housing opportunities, applauded the decision with Executive Director Phyllis Chamberlain issuing the following statement:

“The Housing Alliance of Pennsylvania lauds Governor Wolf for extending the eviction and foreclosure moratoriums to July 10. For those who are struggling, the extension of the moratoriums means not having to worry about losing their homes. Low income renters are disproportionately represented among those that have had COVID-19 related employment losses or reductions, and the executive order is a critical step in alleviating their burdens. But as we move towards the phases of recovery, we must institute programs to stabilize the housing sector. The Housing Alliance will be advocating for long term solutions, including an increase in the availability of resources for renters to pay their rent and for landlords, who also need to meet their own obligations.”
